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PURPOSE OF THE CONTEST:

To test the knowledge and skill of each student in the area of Hairstyling, and to help prepare each student for professional careers in Salons and Hair Studios.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED:

This level of competition will allow young stylists to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following testing areas, which represent fashion conscience clients' requests, found in upscale salons:

Men's Modern Cut and Style Women's Trendy Salon Cut and Style Elegant Evening Long Hair Up-Style No written test will be administered. The theoretical knowledge will be relevant in the performance of the practical tests.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:

Competitors are required to follow all industry safety standards during the competition

EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, TOOLS, AND SUPPLIES:

Equipment Supplied by the Contest Coordinator:

Note:

- All services will be administered on mannequins
- Instruction and training from professionals within the trade is encouraged prior to the commencement of this contest only
 - All hand-held blow dryers cannot exceed 1800 watts
 - All curling irons cannot exceed 125 volts, 60 Hz, 75 Amps
 - Competitors cannot borrow supplies from others

Supplied by Committee:

- One tabletop mirror One double electrical outlet per competitor (extenders permitted)
- Tabletop space
- One male manneguin "Men's Trendy Cut and Style"
- One female long-haired mannequin to be used for the "Elegant Evening Long Hair"
- One female mannequin "Women's Trendy Salon Cut & Style" (hair must be able to have 1" cut off to produce the desired look)

Equipment Supplied by the Competitor:

- All tools and supplies necessary for the completion of all services outlined in these scope sheets
- Mannequin draping (optional)

NOTE: Although there are some tripods available, please bring any tripod that you might have for the mannequins

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

Casual business attire must be worn with DSBN Skills Tees

JUDGING CRITERIA:

PROJECT AND COMPETITION EXPECTATIONS:

Test 1: WOMENS TRENDY SALON CUT & STYLE 9:00 - 10:30 (90 minutes)

The hair must be a trendy fashion haircut and style which is wearable using a combination of lengths from long or short showing technical haircutting skills, which become the model's features. The finished style must compliment the cut. No hair extensions allowed!

- 1.**WET HAIR** Mannequins hair must be wet throughout and combed straight back before the competition begins. Penalties will be given if sages must wet the hair.
- 2. **HAIR LENGTH** One inch (2.5cm) of the hair must be cut throughout the head. Failure to do so will result in demerits. The sages will check the length before and again during the competition to assure that the length is visibly changed. Any hair length in fashion, which suits the model, may be applied.
- 3. **HAIR COLOUR** The choice of colours must reinforce the haircut and entire composition. All colour to be done prior to competition. *No neon colour permitted.*
- 4. **TOOLS AND PRODUCT** Any hair-cutting tool may be used, including styling aids, flatirons, curling irons and apply a light spray finish.
- 5. **CLOTHING** Must comply with day fashion and be appropriate

<u>Test 2: MENS MODERN CUT (11:00 - 12:30) (90minutes)</u>

- 1. **WET HAIR** Models hair must be wet throughout and combed straight back before the competition begins. The sages will check the degree of wetness and the hair lengths. Any infractions will have penalties.
- 2. **HAIR LENGTH** A minimum of one inch must be cut around the entire head, including above or over the ears. Any pre-shaping or pre-cutting will be checked by sages. Failure to do so will result in demerits.
- 3. **TOOLS AND PRODUCTS** Any hair cutting or styling tool may be used, as well as sprays and styling aids. Any handheld electrical tool is allowed to complete the hairstyle.
- 4. **CLOTHING** Trendy. Theatrical costumes and military uniforms not permitted.
- 5. **BEARD** The beard will not be marked as part of the overall cut and style, but it must be cut before the start of the competition.

Test 3: ELEGANT BRIDAL LONG HAIR 1:30 - 3:00 (90 minutes)

This competition is a ladies evening fashion hairstyle, which represents beauty and elegance using the mannequin's own hair.

- 1. **REPORT TO FLOOR** Mannequins will be with clean dry hair and no pre-setting of any kind (rollers or pre-set)
- **2**. **HAIR LENGTH** Minimum hair length in the back to the bottom of shoulder blades. The front may have light fringes not to extend further back than 1 inch from the hairline. The top of the head may have lengths no shorter than jaw length.
- **3. TOOLS AND PRODUCTS** Any electric tools may be used during comb out time. Styling products and hairsprays are allowed.
- **4. HAIR PIECES** No hair pieces of any kind or extensions. Small ornaments only may be allowed.
- **5. HAIR COLOUR** All commercial color are acceptable (NO neon colors)

JUDGING:

Judging will be performance-based and ranked according to the "30 point International System". The top three competitors with the highest accumulative average of all testing units will rank into the following categories:

- 1- Gold Medalist
- 2 Silver Medalist
- 3- Bronze Medalist

Top three medalist placement is announced, however final rank (1st, 2nd, 3rd) will be announced only at the **DSBN Annual Technological Skills Celebration on April 17th, 2019**

Demerits may be given for any rule infractions. Any communication between competitors and audience during contest times may be seen as coaching and could cause demerits to be awarded.

Penalty Points: 6. Length = 1 - 5 points 7. Use of tools = 1 point 8. Out of category = 1 - 3 points 9. Coaching = first warning will incur 1 - 5 point, second warning = disqualification

ENTRY: Students must register online at http://teched.dsbn.org/skills with all of the required information completed to be eligible to participate. Teachers should also forward a list of competitors participating from their school to the contest Advisor, Carla Camelo, 7 days prior to the date of the contest.

TRANSPORTATION: Students are responsible for their own transportation

TEACHER'S ROLE:

Instructors are expected to acquaint their student participants with all of the enclosed guidelines. Teachers may accompany their students or visit any time during the competition, but may not assist the competitors during the challenge
