PURPOSE OF THE CONTEST: Provide Fashion students with an opportunity to apply their technical skills and creativity into the development of a marketable garment for the Fashion Industry. Recognize outstanding students for their excellence in apparel applications.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED:

The competitor will: 1) Design a dress for a 20 – 30 year old female 2) Sew and finish the garment 3) Dress Requirements - dress length – minimum 16"/40 cm to maximum 24"/60 cm from the waist 4) Make use of the contrast fabric in the design / construction 5)Mandatory components that must be maintained : sleeve cap shape, armhole shape 6)Minimum of 2 dart transfers or conversions 7)(2) Two of the following design details : yoke, overlay, design or style line(s), pleat(s), gathers, tucks, vent with mitred corners, slit with mitred corners, belt, tabs, epaulettes 8) An appropriate hem treatment

Specific Requirements - 1) On the day of competition, each competitor will be required to: 1) Submit a coloured 'Fashion Illustration' using the provided croquis at the end of this document. 2) Mount the coloured 'Fashion Illustration' on a body using the provided croquis (at the end of the document) on a bristol board, include front and back views.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS: Safety Glasses

EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, TOOLS, AND SUPPLIES:

Equipment Supplied by the Contest Coordinator:

- 1) Basic dress Pattern – to include front, front placket, back, collar, collar stand, sleeve; 1.2 cm / ½ inch seam allowance included on each pattern
- 2) Fabric – light weight; 150 cm wide, main colour: 2.3 meters, contrast colour: 1.0 metres
- 3) Interfacing (fusible) – 1 metre (20"/50 cm wide)
- 4) Zipper – 14" / 35 cm
- 5) Thread to match o Sewing machines (one per competitor)
- 6) Serger (to be shared)
- 7) Regular presser foot, zipper foot
- 8) Straight pins, tape measure, scissors, shears, weights, seam ripper, pressing tools
- 9) Iron
- 10) Ironing board
